Programme Specific Outcomes (PSOs)

PSO 1: Comprehensive Understanding of the Bodo Language

Students will gain a strong understanding of the phonology, morphology, syntax, semantics, and stylistic features of the Bodo language and use this knowledge in academic and practical contexts.

PSO 2: Knowledge of the Historical Development of Bodo

Students will be able to explain the origin, evolution, migration patterns, and settlement history of the Bodo people, and how these shaped the development of the Bodo language.

PSO 3: Study of Bodo Literature from Origins to Modern Times

Students will understand the history of Bodo literature from the missionary period to the contemporary digital era, including major authors, genres, literary movements, and thematic developments.

PSO 4: Ability to Analyse Literary Texts Critically

Students will develop critical and analytical skills to interpret poetry, fiction, drama, essays, folklore, and children's literature in Bodo using literary theories and comparative approaches.

PSO 5: Cultural and Ethnographic Understanding

Students will understand the cultural identity, traditions, folklore, customs, and social structures of the Bodo community and how these are reflected in language and literature.

PSO 6: Skills in Writing and Creative Expression

Students will be able to produce quality writing in Bodo—creative writing, essays, translations, research projects, and academic papers—with appropriate linguistic and stylistic accuracy.

PSO 7: Documentation and Language Preservation Skills

Students will acquire the ability to conduct fieldwork, collect oral narratives, document endangered dialects, and contribute to the preservation and promotion of the Bodo language.

PSO 8: Proficiency in Translation and Linguistic Application

Students will gain skills in translation (Bodo–English–Assamese) and apply linguistic knowledge in media, communication, education, and administrative fields.

PSO 9: Research and Analytical Competence

Students will develop research skills using qualitative and quantitative methods, and prepare academic reports, research articles, project work, internship reports, and dissertations (for 4th-year).
