# JAWAHARLAL NEHRU COLLEGE: BOKO SESSIONAL/ PRE-SESSIONAL EXAM

### **REPORT**

Examination is one of the most important integral parts of teaching and learning process of every educational institution. For smooth conduct of various examinations, Jawaharlal Nehru College, Boko, constitute an Examination Cell on 14<sup>th</sup> October 2014, with Dr. Nripen Goswami as Officer Incharge and Mr. Monoj Kr. Das as Convener. Presently, the Cell has one Officer Incharge, one Convener, one Assistant Convener, four members from teaching faculty and two members from Non-Teaching staff.

The J N College, Boko, is affiliated to Gauhati University. GU guidelines are strictly followed with respect to evaluation process. There is one Sessional Examination conducted for each semester. The schedules prepared for sessional examination are based on GU academic calendar and the same are communicated to students and faculty through College Notice-Board and other means such Whatsapp, Bulk Messages etc.

To ensure transparency in examination process of the College, a Centre Committee is formed with the following structure.

- 1. Chairman: President of the Governing Body of the College
- 2. Secretary: Principal of the College
- 3. Members:
  - (a) Vice-Principal
  - (b) Three Teaching staff
  - (c) Officer-in Charge, Police station, Boko
  - (d) Post-Master, Post Office, Boko
  - (e) Deputy Superintendent, PHC, Boko
  - (f) Two Office Staff of the College

The College has reformed the continuous internal evaluation system from faculty centric to student centric. The College Examination Cell framed guidelines for conducting the Continuous Internal Evaluation (CIE) in line with academic calendar of GU. As per the guidelines, the following reforms have been carried out effectively for conducting CIE.

- 1) Programmes for Internal Assessment Examination, seating arrangements, invigilator list are prepared for every Examination.
- 2) Question papers for the internal Assessment Examination are set based on knowledge level of students.
- 3) Prepared question papers are scrutinised by HOD and senior faculty members to ensure quality of the paper.
- 4). Monitoring the attendance of the students for the examination
- 5) Internal Assessment has to be carried out within the stipulated time (Class Hour).
- 6) Sessional Examination Programme for all Honors courses are prepared in such a way that it does not hamper normal classes.
- 7) After completion of the Internal Assessment Examination, evaluated answer scripts are distributed to student clarification of doubt or re-correction. Marks secured by student in Sessional Examination are displayed on the notice board of respective department.
- 8) Upload of Internal Assessment marks in GU web Portal.
- 9) The evaluation for laboratory courses (practical part) is assessed in the similar pattern in addition to viva questions.

- 10) The evaluation for project is assessed by conducting periodical project reviews covering key parameters like project presentation skills, communication of ideas, technical knowledge and team work by respective department.
- 11) Performance of the students in Internal Assessment is used for faculties to identify slow and advanced learners in their respective subjects .Slow learners are encouraged to improve their performance in future by conducting Internal Examination and counselling. The exam cell encourages each department to conduct class test on MCQ. Few departments also conduct Examination on Google platform.

Examination Cell has two rooms installed with CCTV, two computers, one Xerox machine, one inverter, seven almirah, ten tables, one fire extinguisher and various examination related materials to ensure smooth conduct of various examinations.

During nation-wide lockdown period due to COVID-19 pandemic, all examination related information such as filling up of Semester Examination form, submission of internal assessment marks, practical marks, are circulated through Examination Whatsapp Group and Bulk messages. Examination Cell provides guidelines and help to student to prepare for online OTBE (Open Text Book Examination). Notices pertaining to examination matter are served on college Notice-Board as well as through online mode such as Whatsapp, Bulk messages for both faculty and students. Some of the Notices served for different purposes are listed as below:

- 1. Guidelines for Setting of Question Papers for Sessional examinations.
- 2. Submission of Question Papers, Internal Assessment Marks, Practical Marks.
- 3. Invigilator duty list for every examination.
- 4. Notice to identify slow learners.
- 5. Programmes for Sessional Examination, Practical Examination and Final Examination.
- 6. Submission of Assignment.
- 7. Form Fill Up for final Examination.
- 8. Correction of subject Code in Admit Card
- 9. Collection of Admit Card

To conduct Examinations smoothly during pandemic period, Examination Cell play an active role in extending help to student through various possible means. The Cell extends help by reaching out to students through whatapps, attending call from student etc. The cell provides proper guidelines to appear OTBE in online mode. Proper training pertaining to OTBE was also given to both students and faculty. Short Video was also prepared by the cell for students with regard how to download question papers, submit scanned answer scripts, etc. The cell resolves any kind of examination related issues faced by the students such as when students could not appeared their examination on account of Medical treatment, student participating in NCC camp, NSS Camp, Ranger Camp etc.
